## Sauvignon Blanc

**MonteVina, 2007, California-** Classic cool climate with characteristics like melon, lemon and grapefruit flavors are balanced by a light grassy note. **Glass** \$8.00 **Bottle** \$28.00

**Clifton Road, 2005, New Zealand-** Tropical aromas with hints of white peaches, pineapple, kiwi, lime, & peach blossoms; crisp & clean flavors of citrus, pear, fig, tropical fruit, honeydew melon & a hint of vanilla oak. **Glass** \$9.50 **Bottle** 33.00

## Chardonnay

**Tobin James, Radiance, 2008, Monterey County~** Firm and well bodied; pear banana, and nectarine flavors finish lingers through supple oak tannins, cream, and hints of vanilla. **Glass** \$7.50 **Bottle** \$28.00

**Beaulieu Vineyard "Coastal Estates," 2008, California-** Golden apple and tropical fruit flavors with toasty vanilla oak nuances. **Glass** \$8.50 **Bottle** \$30.00

**William Hill, 2009, Central Coast-** Aromas and flavors of ripe tree fruit and spice with hints of citrus and tropical notes. Notes of vanilla and toasty oak round out the palate. **Glass** \$9.00 **Bottle** \$32.00

**Simi, 2008, Sonoma County-** Aromas of peach and apricot accented notes of vanilla lightly spiced with hints of clove, cinnamon and toasty; citrus flavors are accented ripe apricot and hints of spice and oak; long, lingering finish. **Glass** \$11.00 **Bottle** \$38.00

**Hess, Su'skol Vineyard, 2008, Napa Valley-** Orange blossom, dried apricot, marzipan, and honeycomb compose the aroma. The palate is rich and tastes of green apple. It's sweetness is balanced with refreshing acidity. **Glass** \$13.00 **Bottle** \$46.00

**Merryvale, 2007, Carneros-** Aromas of hazelnut, tropical fruit and ripe apple are framed by crisp minerality and sweet toasty oak. The wine is rich and creamy with a lingering finish. **Glass** \$13.50 **Bottle** \$47.00

**Rombauer, 2009, Carneros-** Aromas of pears, peaches, and tropical fruit with hints of spice; flavors of fruit and vanilla; crisp acidity and a long, lingering finish. **Glass** \$18.00 **Bottle** \$60.00

## Sparkling & Other Whites

**Ruffino "Lumina" Pinot Grigio, 2009, Venezia, Italy-** Tropical fruity aromas with hints of golden delicious apple; fresh, crisp, and well-structure **Glass** \$9.50 **Bottle** \$33.00

**Trimbach Riesling, 2008, Alsace, France-** Hint of mineral flavor associated with good ripeness; flavors of ripe fruit - white peaches, quince and lemon, with good ripe acidity in the clean, lingering finish **Glass** \$13.00 **Bottle** \$46.00

**L'Estandon, Rosé, 2009, Cotes De Provence, France-** Aromas of raspberry, white and yellow peaches and citrus fruits with a lingering acidity. **Glass** \$7.50 **Bottle** \$26.00

**Chandon, Brut, California-** Exhibits apple and pear flavors with a hint of spice that builds to a soft, dry finish. **Glass** \$7.50 **Bottle** \$26.00

**Alsace Cuvee Les Amours Pinot Blanc, 2007, France-** scented by apple and orange blossoms, with their fruits following on a subtly creamy yet bright palate. **Glass** \$9.50 **Bottle** \$33.00

**Perrier-Jouet Grand Brut, NV, Epernay, Champagne**  
Aromas of green apple, pineapple, and white peach, with rich flavors of fresh butter brioche, and shortbread. **Glass** \$12.50 **Bottle** \$60.00

## Pinot Noir

**Bridlewood, 2009, California-** Dark fruit flavors of currant, plum and blueberry with nuances of vanilla. Well-balanced and a smooth lingering finish. **Glass** \$9.50 **Bottle** \$33.00

**Ceja Vineyards, 2006, Los Carneros, Napa Valley-** Aromas of rose petals, hibiscus, spice, and dark fruit; dense, silky and balanced with structure to age; intense and forward with polished finesse. **Glass** \$14.00 **Bottle** \$50.00

## Merlot

**786, 2008, California-** Starting with aromas of ripe berry, plums leading to a slight sandalwood and black olive fragrance. The flavor profile is berry fruits up front that lead to a soft mid-palate finish. **Glass** \$7.50 **Bottle** \$26.00

**Franciscan, 2005, Napa Valley-** Intense blackberry and black cherry aromas, accented by vanilla-toasted oak with hints of cassis; supple and ripe blackberry, black cherry, toasted oak and vanilla flavors. **Glass** \$10.00 **Bottle** \$33.00

## Zinfandel

**Tobin James Cellars "Ballistic," 2008, Paso Robles-** Over-the-top jammy blackberry and raspberry liqueur flavors join up with chocolaty oak and a bit of pepper spice as the fruit fades into the warm finish. **Glass** \$8.50 **Bottle** \$30.00

**Rombauer, 2008, California-** Full bodied, fruit forward; aromas of black cherry and plum, with a light, spicy character; a dark berry fruit finish lingers on the palate. **Glass** \$15.00 **Bottle** \$42.00

## Cabernet Sauvignon

**Murphy-Goode, 2007, California-** Dark and bold, with explosive cherry and blackberry flavors. **Glass** \$9.50 **Bottle** \$33.00

**Joel Gott 815, 2008, California-** is ripe with blueberry, cherry soda, and dark cherry. The aromas burst with violet vanilla, cedar, chocolate and cinnamon spice. Soft ripe tannins result in a balanced and long velvety finish. **Glass** \$12.50 **Bottle** \$42.00

**Robert Mondavi, 2007, Napa Valley-** Flavors of blackberry, cassis and black plum. **Glass** \$14.50 **Bottle** \$45.00

**Faust, 2006, Napa Valley-** The epitome of Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon, with a burst of intense fruit in the nose, bold and powerful, yet elegant and concentrated. **Glass** \$25.00 **Bottle** \$90.00

**Opus One, 2005, Oakville, Napa (3oz.)-** Well balanced, with appealing spice, currant and blackberry fruit: excellent structure, tannins and acidity, with sturdy currant, blackberry and mineral. **Glass** \$25.00 **Bottle** \$200.00

## Other Reds

**Cline, "Cool Climate" Syrah, 2007, Sonoma Coast-** The deep purple color explodes with fresh blueberry and black cherry jammy fruit spiced with cracked black pepper aromas. **Glass** \$9.00 **Bottle** \$32.00

**Carinae, Malbec, 2009, Argentina-** Aromas of plum and red fruit accompanied by vanilla and smoky oak. **Glass** \$10.00 **Bottle** \$36.00
